

This week Pastor Ken spoke about the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ. He mentioned how it fell on Passover week of the Jewish calendar. Following are some parallels from the feasts that the Jews observed in Leviticus 23 to New Testament events:

1) THE PASSOVER LEV 23:4,5

New Testament parallel: crucifixion

I COR 5:7 Get rid of the old yeast that you may be a new batch without yeast—as you really are. For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed.

2) THE FEAST OF UNLEAVENED BREAD LEV 23:6

New Testament parallel: communion

I COR 5:8 Communion w/ God through Christ.

3) THE FEAST OF FIRSTFRUITS LEV 23:9-11

New Testament parallel: Christ's resurrection

I COR 15:20

4) THE FEAST OF WAVE LOAVES, WEEKS, OR PENTACOST

LEV 23:15-17 50 days after 1st fruits.

New Testament parallel: day of Pentecost

ACTS 2:1-4 Occurred on the feast of Pentecost.

5) THE FEAST OF TRUMPETS

New Testament parallel: the rapture

I COR 15:52 Blowing of the trumpet of the rapture.

6) THE DAY OF ATONEMENT LEV 23:26,27

New Testament parallel: the 2nd coming

HEB 9:28 Christ was our scapegoat.

7) THE FEAST OF TABERNACLES LEV 23:34

New Testament parallel: the millennium

ZECH 14:16 Tabernacles is reinstated during the millennium.
